- Before feeding a baby
- After every visit to the toilet
- After cleaning a baby's bottom

This simple educational play engages on an emotional level that quickly becomes competitive as participants see the opportunities and risks they face, while trying to be the first to reach the end goal.

This engagement, followed up with skilled facilitation, ensures that your participants can't fail to go away wanting to wash their hands properly and more regularly every day!
